

# *The Hebrew Names of God*

## Lesson 11: Yahweh Roi

- I. **Yahweh Roi** is translated “The Lord my shepherd” and looks at the character of God as one who leads, feeds, protects and provides for His children—*Psalms 23:1–6*.
  - A. Yahweh Roi personally provides for His sheep—*Psalms 23:1*.
  - B. Yahweh Roi directs the life of His sheep in a way that is best for them—*Psalms 23:2*.
  - C. Yahweh Roi provides personal restoration and leadership that reflects His character so His name is magnified—*Psalms 23:3*.
  - D. Yahweh Roi provides His sheep with His personal presence and comfort in times of uncertainty—*Psalms 23:4*.
  - E. Yahweh Roi blesses His sheep by feeding them and protecting them from the enemies that want to hurt them—*Psalms 23:5*.
  - F. Yahweh Roi’s sheep experience the essence of His person, which includes His goodness and His mercy—*Psalms 23:6*.
  
- II. **David**, the king of Israel and sweet psalmist, appeals to Yahweh to shepherd His people in light of His character—*Psalms 28:5–9*.
  
- III. **Isaiah** described Yahweh as one Who will tenderly care for His sheep—*Isaiah 40:10–11*.
  
- IV. **Christ** comes as the good shepherd who lays down His life for His sheep—*John 10:11*.
