



Lesson 3: The Seven Figures of the Church

l.	The Head and the Body of Christ: Jesus Christ is the head of His body, which is composed of all who have believed
	in Him and have been baptized by the Holy Spirit into Him—1 Corinthians 12:12–31.

II. **The last Adam and His new creation:** The incarnate Son is the last Adam, Who imparts new life to those who are under the sentence of death caused by the first Adam—1 **Corinthians 15:45; Romans 5:12–21.**

III.	The Shepherd and His sheep: The Savior gave His life for His people and sustains them in time and eternity—
	John 10:1–30.

- IV. **The Chief Cornerstone and the living stones**: Jesus Christ is the chief cornerstone Who oversees how His people form God's living house—**Ephesians 2:19–22; 1 Peter 2:4–8.**
- V. **The Bridegroom and His bride**: The Savior sacrificially loves His people and is maturing us to be with Him in an eternal home He is preparing for us—John 14:2–3; Ephesians 5:25–32.
- VI. **The High Priest and His royal priesthood:** Jesus Christ is the High Priest over a royal priesthood, who continually offer sacrifices to the Father (cp. Hebrews 13:15–16)—1 Peter 2:5–9.
- VII. The Vine and His branches: The Lord Jesus is the sole source of life and fruitfulness in His people—John 15:1–8.
